I specialized in behavioral psychology that my mom paid for the first time, and then I had to give up because of family problems, so when I decided to come back, she didn't want to pay a second time. I did some local stuff in Toronto that was under a different name and so on and then took a break from it for a few years. Then a good friend of mine, Bruce Beckham, decided to get back into it after seven years of hiatus and kind of threw it out there for me to do so as well. We were a little in love, so it was an excuse to work together. Then I started working with Titan. TitanMen has spoiled me, it's like a gay summer camp; a nice paid vacation with some big kids. They take very good care of us. Did you have any inspiration from men who were already in the industry that prompted you to join? Not too much, honestly. I don't have any social media linked to my alter ego, I've never really wanted to get too into it. It was a great way for me to make money, meet people and travel a little. I grew up a skinny, nerdy introvert so what better way to break out of your shell in a big way than do porn! I've always had small n porn crashes, but as a modeling myself after anyone I kind of just go with a good attitude and be me. I'm still new to all this, in terms of Plan of things, so I don't feel Jason Vario still has an ID. It's interesting that you mention that he's a skinny introvert as this seems to be a very common thing with men in the industry. I've always been very liberal, my mom is extremely liberal, so sexually I've never been repressed and all my life I've been for pleasure and new experiences because because to live an interesting life in this way. I got into fitness not for vanity, it was more because I was a very sick kid all the time so it was more about improving my diet. He's totally my type - down strength, beefy, muscle, all that. That was a lot of fun. Do you have someone in the industry you're dying to work with? I'm really really open to recommendations because I don't follow any of them; I'm not on social media and I don't have pornstar friends other than the ones I mentioned. I'm really new to it as there are guys I'll see in a particular scene that I think is really gorgeous, but I don't know their names on their own. Right now I'm only doing a safe job (condom), which limits my options. I'm open to working with anyone, because people I didn't think I'd have anything to do with had really amazing ones with, and then what I thought I really didn't have. There's what you see on the surface and then behind the curtain, so I'm open to anyone. I appreciate big, burly muscle, so that's what my guy usually tends to be, but then the connection can trump anything. You raised it before, about barebacking in the industry. Thoughts on that? Let's be honest. It's hot, spontaneous and in the moment, but you need to have training behind it and risk assessment as well. I have mixed feelings about pRep in the community; HIV rates have decreased which is great, but along with it every other thing has increased, exponentially. I have a lot of friends who work in clinics and it's a bit of a double-edged sword where it protects the big scary AKA one thing, but then it doesn't do it for all the other diseases you can get. I'll be in New York and go on Grindr and Scruff and catch a lot of guys lying, saying they were in pRep just to make an excuse to bareback when they were actually in retrovirals and already had. I know human nature, my studies were in behavioral psychology, and everyone's lying to some degree. Was. Was. really disheartening to see the amount of people who will be lying about it and won't take into account their safety. I've always referred to pRep as your airbag, and condoms are your seat belt - you should use both. It shouldn't be your automatic transition, and I know friends who don't even know what a condom is anymore. It's frustrating. I would go to Europe and the children there would assume I was undetectable. It didn't make any sense. Of course I have nothing against guys who are HIV positive, two of my exes are, however I found this bothering while I was there. I grew up in Calgary, where there's no scene here whatsoever, so I'll go long lengths of time without sex. I'd rather jerk off or find someone I can have more intimate sex with than risk it. That sounds funny, but I've been tested every time before I go down to a shoot where I have my results with me in my wallet. I have a partner now, but when I found them, I'd carry them. People thought it was weird, they thought it was a trick, but it was really for me to cover my bases.
